

ELECTION INTEGRITY

Disappointed by SB 214 & Support SB 423

The assembly has failed us on Election Integrity AGAIN.

On Tuesday, **SB214** (EI bill that crossed over last year)

[Georgia General Assembly - SB 214](#)

was made even worse by the House Government Affairs committee and added nothing from SB568. They kicked the can down the road on QR codes. Provide for on demand ballot printing which are by definition hand marked (but after the 2026 election), but no ballot ID. This is basically a new vendor bill. **DO NOT TAKE THE AUDITING POWER AWAY FROM SEB: One good thing in this bill is the auditing power going from SoS to SEB.** They have to do something, otherwise courts will be involved and SB189 will carry the day and they can't implement the bill.

TAKE ACTION: No action at this time on the bill. We are figuring out if a few small tweaks will be allowed. They have to pass this bill, so we are determining if it is worth trying to sink this bill in its current form. Talk to Your Senator/Your Rep, and let them know you are disgusted that they couldn't secure our elections for 2026 and if they lose, they deserve it. The tweaks include making the new software nonproprietary vs another Dominion. They need to audit the actual ballots, not the images.
