GUIDELINES TO SPEAK AT THE ROPES

AT THE ROPES: Ask your rep/senator to the ropes with Yellow Cards. Go in pairs. Don't go in big groups. Don't play good cop/bad cop because we need one person to build rapport and second to support not throw a grenade into the mix.

ATTITUDE: Be assertive (not aggressive or rude). Be respectful of their time and keep it short. It is a hectic day.

THANK your Rep/Senator – thank you for all the hard work this session & for taking time to talk to me.

THEIR POSITION: "Where do you stand on SB 74 Harmful Materials for Minors in Libraries?"

AGREE: If they **agree**, let's influence others:

"Do you know what other Representatives I can speak to who may be on the fence?"

DISAGREE: If they **disagree**:

"What are a few reasons why you oppose?"

"Do you have a few minutes? This is why I strongly support this bill..."

"Ex: I want a simple act of moving mature materials to an Adult-only section out of school libraries.

We want the librarian to be accountable and keep young children away from horrific content."

"I hope you will do the right thing AND thank you for your time...."

SUPPORT HB960 - Election integrity bill formerly known as SB568. The HOUSE is voting on a final agreement vote because of the Senate's changes to HB 960.

*Put pressure on [Speaker Burns](#) to agree with and pass the Senate version of the bill.

Ask them to add the "audit piece" from SB 214 when it goes to conference committee – this insures the SEB will have the power of the audit for 2026.

OPPOSE HB 154 Permanent Daylight Savings Time – Senate passed a substitute, so it has to go House for vote on the overhauled bill. Later than 8am sunrise for 4.5 months + January later than 9am sunrise.

Moves Georgia out of Eastern Standard Time. We can want to remove changing the clocks but this isn't the solution.
